NeighborWorks America is a public nonprofit organization, established by Congress in 1978 as the Neighborhood Reinvestment Corporation (Public Law 95-557) to expand opportunities for people to live in affordable homes, improve their lives and strengthen their communities. NeighborWorks pursues this mission through its support of a network of nearly 250 nonprofit housing and community development organizations, which provide on-the-ground support to families and communities in every state, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and Tribal lands.

NeighborWorks leverages its national reach and expertise to build technical skills and organizational capacity, supplement financial resources, and amplify the efforts of these local and regional nonprofit organizations while also acting as a bridge to partners from across the nonprofit, for-profit and public sectors to achieve lasting results. Through a unique mix of programming and services tailored to meet local needs, NeighborWorks network organizations develop service-enriched rental housing, spearhead community stabilization and engagement activities to revitalize neighborhoods affected by economic downturn or natural disasters, and work to rebuild pathways to improved credit, savings and sustainable homeownership for low- to moderate-income families and individuals.

NeighborWorks leveraged more than \$11.64 billion in direct investment in communities in FY 2025, attracting \$74 for each federal dollar appropriated.

NeighborWorks America provides network organizations with flexible grants to meet their communities' highest priorities, tailored technical assistance to maximize their impact, best-in-class training and more. As a committed steward of taxpayer resources, NeighborWorks America also conducts rigorous oversight and annual assessment of each organization's fiscal and organizational health to ensure accountability.
